

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# CLIMATE

Averaging 300 days of sunshine annually, Namibia is among the sunniest countries in the world. The climate of the interior is generally arid with very low humidity. This reaches an extreme in the Namib Desert, one of the driest on the planet.

The coast is cooler than most people expect, thanks to the Benguela Current, which can produce lots of thick mist and freezing water. In winter the temperatures are generally around the low 20s (°C), while summers are hot in the mid 30s to low 40s. A general rule is that the further south you go, the less it rains, and the same is true when travelling from east to west, from a maximum rainfall of 600mm in the northeast to the southwest with an average of 0mm.

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

I definitely think I caught the bug for adventure, and I'm already planning my next expedition. Watch this space!



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

We parked up at the Bushman rock engravings, next to the ‘Fountain of Doubt’, an ancient spring. Here we stretched our legs with a beautiful walk around the area – the air felt magical, as if the echoes of Stone Age hunters were still rebounding off the cave walls.



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# DAY 4

## Etosha National Park (Kamdescha Route).

Today we had a spectacular drive along the Kamdescha route, with some seriously dusty roads. We were spraying red and brown dust into the air as if it were water on a lake, you could see our trail for miles. 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
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# DAY 9
